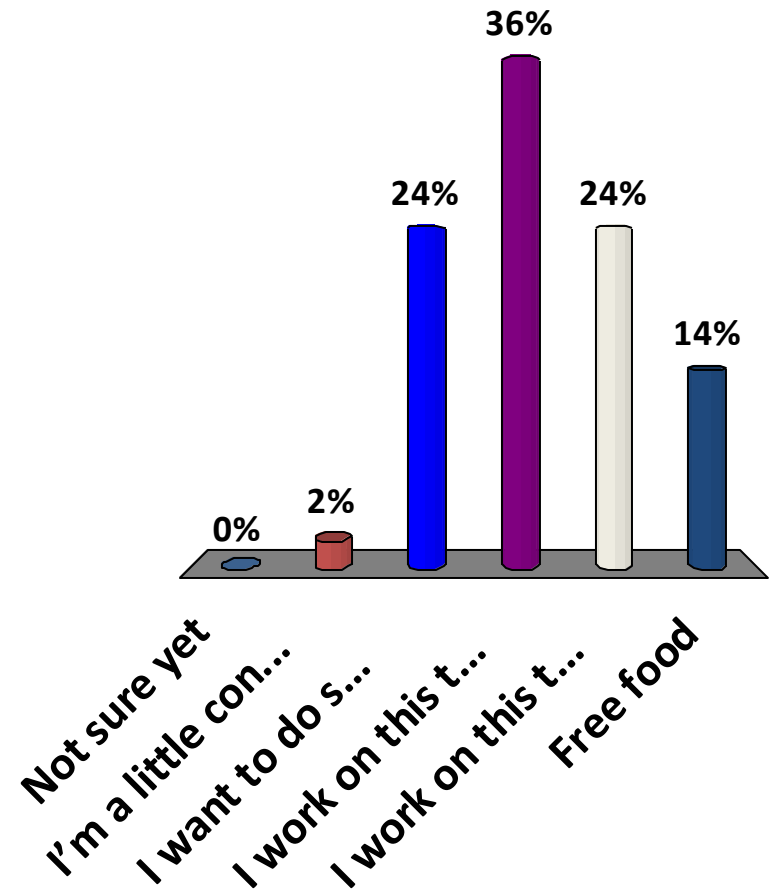


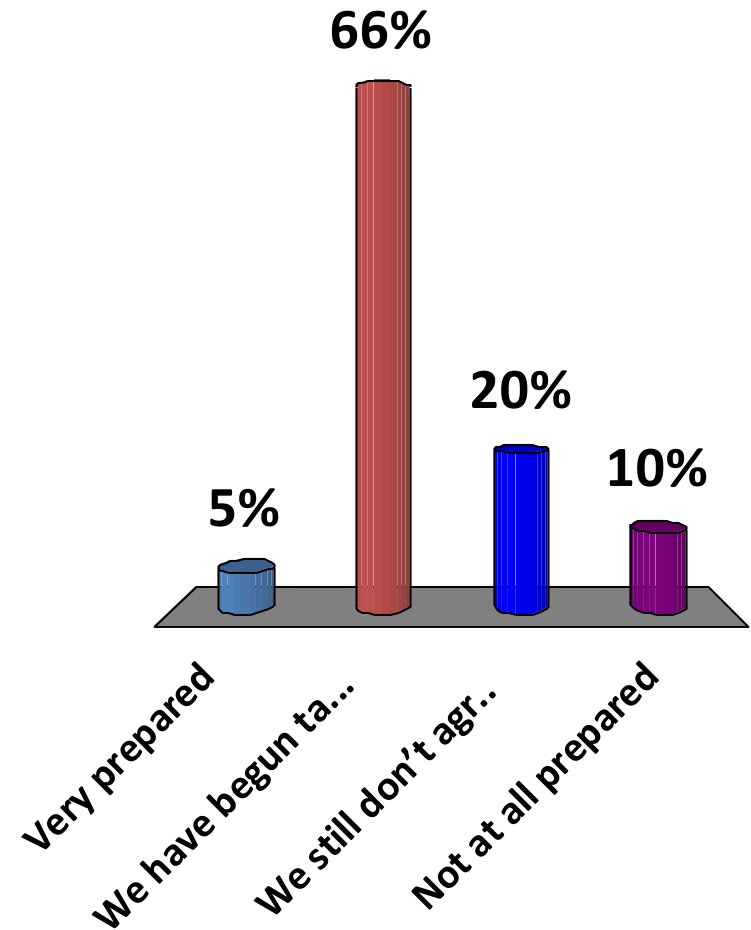

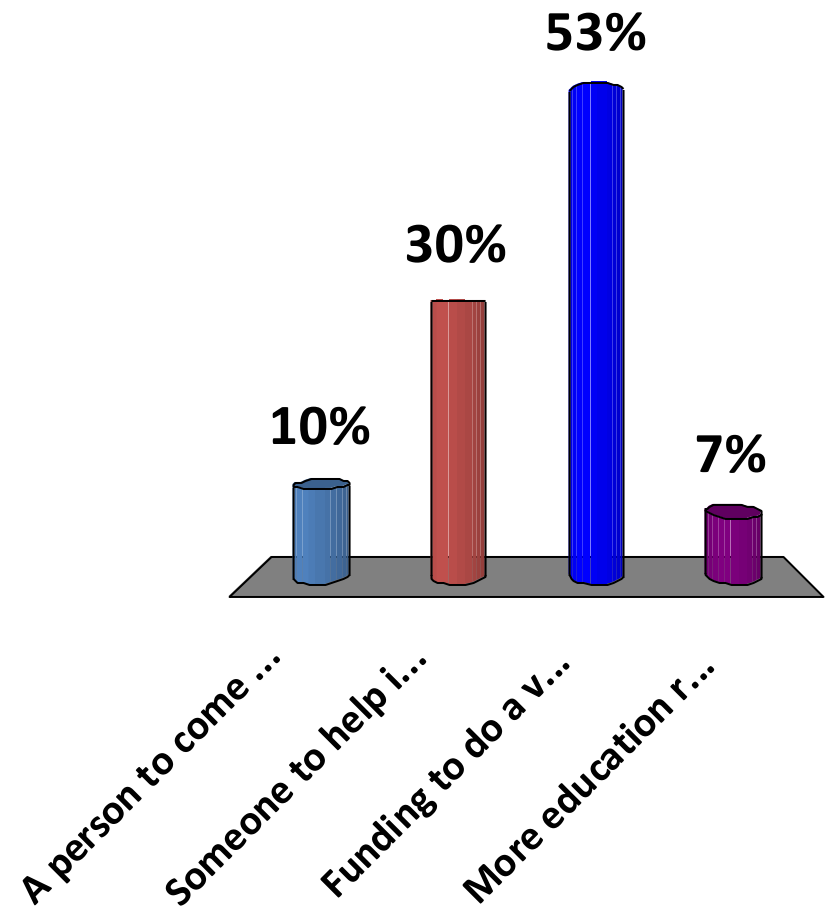
How prepared to you feel you community is for climate impacts?

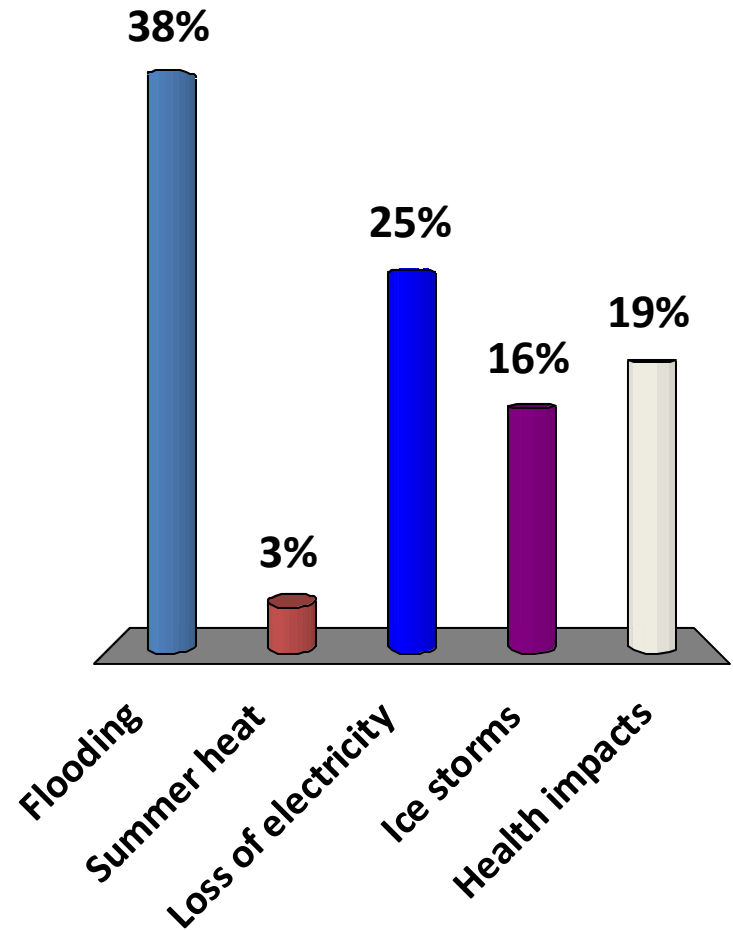

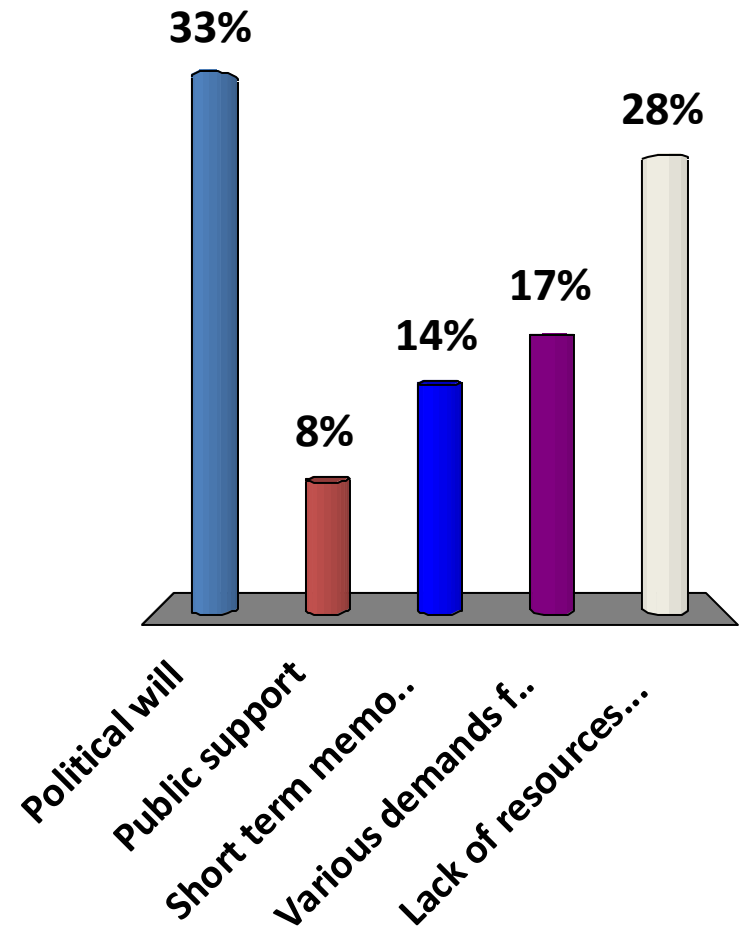

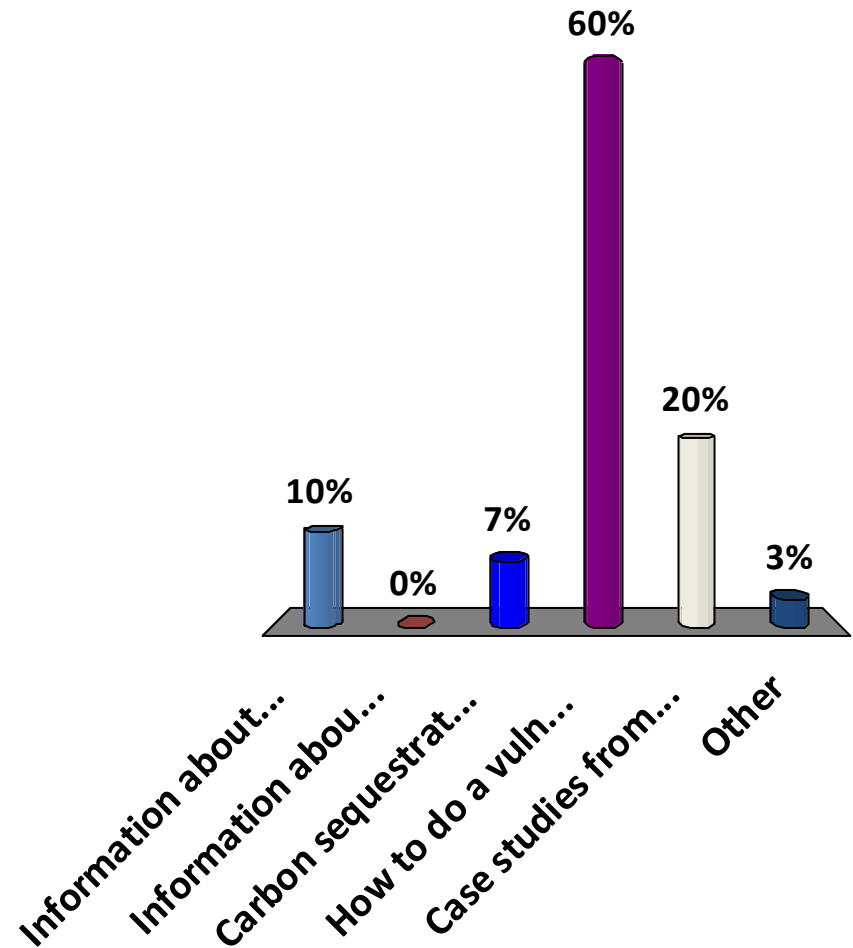
