#### **About Climate Change**

- Wide scientific agreement National Academy of Science, NOAA, American Geophysical Union, US Global Change Research Program, IPCC etc...
- It is happening now we can see it in our own lives. Record breaking temperatures, extreme weather events...
- We contribute to it fossil fuels make CO<sub>2</sub>; CO<sub>2</sub> traps heat
- We have a choice
  - We can decrease our CO<sub>2</sub> emissions
  - Communities can become more resilient
  - We can reduce impacts with engagement & technology

# We have met environmental challenges in the past!

- 40 years ago Smog
  - Solution: Catalytic converters
  - Smog reduced by one-third to one-half
- 25 years ago Ozone layer destruction
  - Solution: Chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) phase out
  - CFCs all but eliminated, ozone layer (slowly) rebounding
- 20 years ago Acid Rain
  - Solution: "cap and trade" system for regulating utility SO<sub>2</sub> emissions
  - Acid rain emissions cut by 1/2; forests rebounding, lakes (slowly) rebounding
